<b>Summary:</b>  <b><u>Premises/Estates Technology Transformation Fund (ETTF)</u></b>  Building works are ongoing at the new Castle Partnership – Gurney Surgery situated at 40 Fishergate, Norwich, with completion due by July 2019.  <b><u>Estates Strategy</u></b>  All the Estates information from Practices, in order to understand the Estates Capacity moving forward has been captured and entered onto the SHAPE system by the STP Estates Manager. Planning data and population data has also been entered onto SHAPE in order to inform the Norwich New Model of Care Estates strategy, which has recently been drafted. This will now be circulated for comment to members of the Your Norwich Estates Group at the next Your Norwich Estates meeting due to be held on the 25 <sup>th</sup> February 2019. Once agreed the Estates Strategy will be submitted for approval at the next meeting of the Primary Care Delegated Commissioning Committee.  Once the strategy/plan has been developed and the outcomes reviewed, presenting an overall picture of estates needs for Norwich to address the rising population, the CCG will liaise with affected practices to address the issues that have arisen.
